Categories 1-6, Groups 1-21 & Types 1-61 are arranged in order of deprivation with the lowest deprivation at the top of the table to the highest deprivation at the bottom.

The remaining Acorn definitions (Category 7, Group 22, Types 62-65) are reserved for other kinds of postcode, primarily communal population and postcodes with no resident population and are not hierarchical.
