## **Staffing Changes**

We hope this letter finds you well as we approach the half-term break. We are writing to share some important staffing updates that will affect children in Early Years, Year 3, Year 4 and Year 5.

As part of our ongoing commitment to provide a high-quality education, we have decided to implement some changes within our staffing structure until the end of this academic year. Following the successful trial of splitting the children by year groups in the mornings, we have now decided that Year 3, Year 4, and Year 5 classes will be organised into separate classes full-time. The aim of this adjustment is to create smaller class sizes, allowing for a more personalised approach to learning that meets the diverse needs of all our students.

From after the half-term break, Miss Mills will assume the role of the teacher for Year 3. Year 3 students will enter the school through the Key Stage 1 door each morning, met by Miss Mills.

Mrs Bell will take over teaching Year 4. Meanwhile, Mr Askwith will be in charge of Year 5.

Additionally, Miss Dodds will now spend her entire day in Early Years. She has proven to be a great addition to the team, and her full-time presence will enrich the educational experiences of our youngest learners.

We remain committed to maintaining strong communication with you and welcome any feedback or questions about these developments.
