STAFFING UPDATE

I hope this letter finds you well. As we approach the half-term break, I wish to provide you with an important update regarding staffing and our teaching arrangements.

After the half-term, we will be grouping the children into their respective year groups for the core subjects of Mathematics and English. This change is implemented to enable more focused teaching and learning tailored to the specific learning needs of each year group. I would like to reassure you that your child's class teacher will remain unchanged. However, for English and Mathematics, teaching will occur in smaller groups to enhance the effectiveness of teaching these vital skills.

In Year 3, the students will be taught by Mrs Anderson. Year 4 will benefit from the expertise of Mrs Bell, while Mr Askwith will take charge of Year 5. Lastly, the Year 6 students will be in the capable hands of Miss Hall. For our younger children, Reception will join Nursery for their afternoon sessions with Mrs Mills, while Mrs Graham will oversee Year 1 in the afternoons, enabling Mrs Arkless to concentrate on Year 2.

This strategic approach allows us to create smaller groups, facilitating targeted support and personalised learning experiences. Not only does this arrangement enable us to address individual needs more effectively, but it also allows us to concentrate specifically on the curriculum for each year group. We believe this will foster a collaborative and an engaging learning atmosphere where students can flourish.
