Adapted Teaching Strategies

- Lessons are chunked into manageable parts and simplified to reduce cognitive overload.
- Multi-sensory approaches are emphasized, such as combining sound, movement, and visuals to engage different learning styles.
- Brain breaks and physical activities (e.g., singing, body movement, playing tuned/untuned instruments) are integrated to maintain focus.

Extracurricular Opportunities

 SEND pupils are encouraged to join singing assemblies, choirs, and performance opportunities to build confidence and social skills.

Access to Resources and Expertise

Schools are encouraged to provide access to specialist instruments, adaptive technologies, and trained music educators who understand SEND needs.
