Dear Parents and Carers of Year 5 and 6

We are writing to ask for your support in helping to keep all of our children safe online.

**We have recently been made aware of concerns involving pupils using Snapchat, including reports of indecent images being shared** and children discussing ways to distribute them. Situations like this are taken extremely seriously, and we want to work together with families to ensure children are protected.

In school, we will be delivering further sessions on **online safety**, including what to do if children receive inappropriate content, and how to make safe and responsible choices when using digital devices.

We kindly ask parents and carers to please:

- **Check your child's phone and online activity regularly**, particularly if they have access to Snapchat or similar apps.
- **Discuss with your child what to do if they encounter inappropriate messages or images.**
- **Supervise their device use** and make sure privacy and safety settings are enabled.
- **Ensure they only use age-appropriate apps and online content.**

We also want to remind you that **Snapchat has a minimum age requirement of 13**. Children below this age should not have their own account.
